#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended December 24 member bank reserve balances increased \$33,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from a decrease of \$39,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and increases of \$30,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit and \$32,000,000 in gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$101,000,000 in money in circulation, \$9,000,000 in Treasury cash, and \$9,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on December 24 were estimated to be approximately \$6,440,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 for the week.
