#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended December 31 member bank reserve balances increased \$189,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$54,000,000 in money in circulation and \$113,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and increases of \$65,000,000 in gold stock and \$5,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$62,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit and an increase of \$16,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on December 31 were estimated to be approximately \$6,620,000,000, an increase of \$180,000,000 for the week.
