#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended February 19 member bank reserve balances increased \$150,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from decreases of \$143,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$53,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and increases of \$10,000,000 in gold stock and \$2,000,000 in Treasury currency, offset in part by a decrease of \$25,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit and increases of \$23,000,000 in money in circulation and \$10,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on February 19 were estimated to be approximately \$6,440,000,000, an increase of \$110,000,000 for the week.
