#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 12 member bank reserve balances increased \$75,000,000. Additions to member bank reserves arose from increases of \$81,000,000 in gold stock, \$7,000,000 in Reserve Bank credit, and \$3,000,000 in Treasury currency, and a decrease of \$24,000,000 in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, offset in part by increases of \$30,000,000 in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$6,000,000 in money in circulation, and \$4,000,000 in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on March 12 were estimated to be approximately \$6,480,000,000, an increase of \$40,000,000 for the week.
