CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended January 11 member bank reserve balances decreased \$369 million. Reductions in member bank reserves resulted from a decrease of \$827 million in Reserve Bank credit and an increase of \$78 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, offset in part by decreases of \$292 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$240 million in money in circulation, and \$6 million in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on January 11 were estimated to be approximately \$1,090 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances increased \$4 million while holdings of United States Government securities decreased \$599 million, the latter change reflecting decreases of \$611 million in bills, \$47 million in bonds, and \$1 million in notes, and an increase of \$60 million in certificates.
