CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended February 1 member bank reserve balances increased \$113 million. Additions to member bank reserves resulted from increases of \$320 million in Reserve Bank credit, \$3 million in Treasury currency and a decrease of \$3 million in Treasury cash, offset in part by increases of \$98 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$70 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, \$15 million in money in circulation and a decrease of \$30 million in gold stock. Excess reserves of member banks on February 1 were estimated to be approximately \$1,010 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances increased \$335 million and of United States Government securities \$91 million, the latter change reflecting increases of \$107 million in notes, \$77 million in bills, and decreases of \$66 million in certificates and \$27 million in bonds.
