### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 1, member bank reserve balances increased \$112 million. Additions to member bank reserves resulted from increases of \$362 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$2 million in Treasury currency, offset in part by increases of \$175 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$41 million in money in circulation, \$30 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts and \$5 million in Treasury cash. Excess reserves of member banks on March 1 were estimated to be approximately \$920 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances increased \$220 million and of United States Government securities \$132 million, the latter change reflecting increases of \$562 million in notes and \$120 million in bills, and decreases of \$503 million in certificates and \$47 million in bonds.
