#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended March 29 member bank reserve balances decreased \$187 million. Reductions in member bank reserves resulted from increases of \$238 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$13 million in Treasury cash, and \$21 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and a decrease of \$25 million in gold stock, offset in part by an increase of \$108 million in Reserve Bank credit and a decrease of \$3 million in money in circulation. Excess reserves of member banks on March 29 were estimated to be approximately \$500 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances increased \$178 million, while holdings of United States Government securities decreased \$57 million, the latter change reflecting increases of \$46 million in bills and \$10 million in certificates and a decrease of \$113 million in bonds.
