## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 12 member bank reserve balances increased \$25 million. Additions to member bank reserves resulted from decreases of \$61 million in money in circulation, \$35 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$4 million in Treasury cash, offset in part by a decrease of \$64 million in Reserve Bank credit and an increase of \$10 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts. Excess reserves of member banks on April 12 were estimated to be approximately \$750 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances decreased \$9 million, while holdings of United States Government securities increased \$25 million, the latter change reflecting increases of \$43 million in bills and \$12 million in certificates and a decrease of \$30 million in bonds.
