CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended April 19 member bank reserve balances decreased \$210 million. Reductions in member bank reserves resulted from a decrease of \$140 million in Reserve Bank credit and increases of \$86 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, \$60 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$6 million in Treasury cash, offset in part by a decrease of \$80 million in money in circulation. Excess reserves of member banks on April 19 were estimated to be approximately \$560 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances decreased \$23 million and of United States Government securities \$187 million, the latter change reflecting decreases of \$107 million in bonds, \$52 million in certificates and \$28 million in bills.
