CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended May 17 member bank reserve balances increased \$216 million. Additions to member bank reserves resulted from decreases of \$107 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$61 million in money in circulation, \$24 million in Treasury cash, and \$22 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and an increase of \$23 million in Reserve Bank credit, offset in part by a decrease of \$19 million in gold stock. Excess reserves of member banks on May 17 were estimated to be approximately \$880 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances decreased \$11 million and of United States Government securities \$190 million, the latter change reflecting decreases of \$164 million in bills and \$65 million in bonds and increases of \$23 million in certificates and \$16 million in notes.
