CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

During the week ended August 30, member bank reserve balances decreased \$157 million. Reductions in member bank reserves resulted from increases of \$114 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$79 million in money in circulation, and \$12 million in nonmember deposits and other Federal Reserve accounts, and a decrease of \$51 million in gold stock, offset in part by increases of \$96 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$2 million in Treasury currency outstanding. Excess reserves of member banks on August 30 were estimated to be approximately \$540 million.

Holdings of loans, discounts and advances decreased \$8 million, while holdings of United States Government securities increased \$7 million, the latter change reflecting increases of \$1,146 million in certificates and \$1,111 million in bonds, and decreases of \$1,252 million in notes and \$998 million in bills.
