#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

### Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended January 10, member bank reserves decreased \$189 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were decreases of \$644 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$160 million in gold stock. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$273 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$270 million in Money in circulation, and \$84 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$644 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$582 million in Reserve Bank float and \$110 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, and an increase of \$46 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected decreases of \$106 million in notes and \$54 million in bills, and an increase of \$50 million in bonds.
