### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

#### Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended January 24, Member bank reserve balances decreased \$327 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were decreases of \$315 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$51 million in Gold stock and increases of \$151 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$36 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$172 million in Money in circulation and \$54 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$315 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$253 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$234 million in Reserve Bank float, and an increase of \$172 million in holdings of Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected decreases of \$160 million in notes, \$93 million in bills, and \$.3 million in bonds.
