CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended January 31, Member bank reserves increased \$724 million. The principal change adding to reserves was an increase of \$1,443 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were a decrease of \$51 million in Gold stock and increases of \$551 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$95 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$17 million in Money in circulation, and \$16 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The increase of \$1,443 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$939 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities and of \$526 million in Loans, discounts and advances, and a decrease of \$22 million in Reserve Bank float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$534 million in bills, \$218 million in bonds, and \$187 million in notes.

The increase for the week of \$452 million in Required reserves of member banks reflected the higher reserve requirements which became effective during the week and which raised Required reserves approximately \$600 million.
