CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

Furing the week ended February 7, Member bank reserves increased \$91 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$209 million in Reserve Bank credit, and decreases of \$27 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$12 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$80 million in Money in circulation and \$21 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$51 million in Gold stock.

The increase of \$209 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$208 million in Float and \$157 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, and a decrease of \$156 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$114 million in bonds and \$80 million in notes, and a decrease of \$37 million in bills.

The increase for the week of \$230 million in Required reserves of member banks reflected the higher reserve requirements which became effective during the week and which raised required reserves approximately \$280 million.
