CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 28, Member bank reserves increased \$132 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$331 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$49 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$121 million in Gold stock and \$95 million in Reserve Bank credit, and increases of \$24 million in Money in circulation and \$16 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$95 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from a decrease of \$324 million in Float, and increases of \$201 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$27 million in U. S. Government securities. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$86 million in notes and \$73 million in bonds, and a decrease of \$132 million in bills.
