CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended March 7, Member bank reserves decreased \$62 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were a decrease of \$135 million in Gold stock, and increases of \$31 million in Money in circulation, \$30 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$16 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$15 million in Treasury cash holdings. The principal offsetting changes were a decrease of \$123 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and an increase of \$38 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The increase of \$38 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$298 million in U. S. Government securities, and decreases of \$190 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$69 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$199 million in Bonds and \$103 million in notes, and a decrease of \$4 million in bills.
