CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended June 6 Member bank reserves increased \$690 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$481 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$120 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and an increase of \$150 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$59 million in Money in circulation.

The increase of \$150 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$360 million in U. S. Government securities and \$200 million in Float, and a decrease of \$411 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$399 million in notes and \$150 million in bonds, and a decrease of \$189 million in bills.
