CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended August 1, Member bank reserves increased \$11 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$219 million in Reserve Bank credit, and decreases of \$52 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$45 million in Other F. R. accounts (net). The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$136 million in Money in circulation, \$133 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$36 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The increase of \$219 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$330 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$24 million in U. S. Government securities, and a decrease of \$134 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$1,658 million in certificates and \$21 million in bills, and a decrease of \$1,655 million in notes.
