CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended October 3, Member bank reserves increased \$635 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$419 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$44 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$14 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and an increase of \$353 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$183 million in Money in circulation and \$22 million in Other F. R. accounts (net).

The increase of \$353 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$565 million in U. S. Government securities, and decreases of \$147 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$66 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$310 million in notes, \$185 million in certificates, \$67 million in bills, and \$3 million in bonds.
