## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended October 31, Member bank reserves decreased \$276 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were a decrease of \$414 million in Reserve Bank credit and increases of \$109 million in Money in circulation and \$31 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$99 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$70 million in Other F. R. accounts (net), and \$16 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and an increase of \$90 million in Gold stock.

The decrease of \$414 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$334 million in Float and \$114 million in U. S. Government securities and an increase of \$34 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$114 million in bills.
