CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended November 14, Member bank reserves increased \$183 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$207 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$54 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$7 million in Treasury cash holdings, and an increase of \$7 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$67 million in Money in circulation and \$26 million-in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The increase of \$7 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$86 million in Float and \$30 million in Loans, discounts and advances, and a decrease of \$110 million in U. S. Government securities. The change in U. S. Government securities reflected decreases of \$78 million in bills and \$32 million in certificates.
