CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended December 26, Member Bank reserves decreased \$590 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$283 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$140 million in Money in circulation, \$91 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$13 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$169 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$60 million in Gold stock, and a decrease of \$50 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$169 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from a decrease of \$781 million in Float, and increases of \$348 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$264 million in U. S. Government securities. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$209 million in bills, \$47 million in certificates, and \$8 million in bonds.
