#### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

#### Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended January 2, Member bank reserves increased \$156 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$281 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$260 million in Money in circulation, \$99 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$87 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$87 million in Other F. R. accounts (net), and \$14 million in Treasury cash holdings, and an increase of \$76 million in Gold stock. These changes were largely offset by a decrease of \$751 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The decrease of \$751 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$691 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$215 million in Float, and an increase of \$155 million in U. S. Government securities. The increase in U. S. Government securities reflected increases of \$162 million in bills and \$2 million in bonds, and a decrease of \$9 million in certificates.
