CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended January 16, Member bank reserves increased \$119 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$274 million in Money in circulation and \$58 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and an increase of \$50 million in Gold stock. The principal offsetting changes were a decrease of \$182 million in Reserve Bank credit, and increases of \$69 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$11 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$182 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$333 million in U. S. Government securities and \$63 million in Loans, discounts and advances, and an increase of \$214 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected decreases of \$212 million in bills and \$121 million in certificates.
