CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 20, Member bank reserves decreased \$87 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$230 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$48 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$32 million in Treasury cash holdings, and \$16 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$134 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$60 million in Gold stock, and a decrease of \$38 million in Money in circulation.

The increase of \$134 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$399 million in Float and decreases of \$165 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$99 million in U. S. Government securities. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$226 million in certificates and an increase of \$127 million in bonds.
