CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended March 5, Member bank reserves increased \$77 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were increases of \$180 million in Gold stock and \$133 million in Reserve Bank credit, and decreases of \$42 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$12 million in Treasury cash holdings. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$88 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$77 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$74 million in Money in circulation, and \$52 million in Other F. R. accounts (net).

The increase of \$133 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$213 million in Float and decreases of \$41 million in U. S. Government securities and \$39 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$41 million in certificates.
