# CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended May 21, Member bank reserves increased \$174 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$30 million in Reserve Bank credit and decreases of \$132 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$16 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$14 million in Money in circulation, and \$14 million in Treasury cash holdings, which were partially offset by an increase of \$33 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The increase of \$30 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$235 million in Float and decreases of \$172 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$32 million in U. S. Government securities. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$82 million in certificates and an increase of \$50 million in bills.
