CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended May 28, Member bank reserves decreased \$460 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$227 million in Money in circulation, \$174 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$25 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$52 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting change was a decrease of \$25 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$52 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$360 million in Float and \$10 million in U. S. Government securities, and an increase of \$317 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$42 million in certificates and an increase of \$32 million in bills.
