### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

#### Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 11, Member bank reserves decreased \$208 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were decreases of \$236 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$103 million in Gold stock, and increases of \$119 million in Money in circulation and \$14 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$241 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$19 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$236 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$121 million in Float, \$60 million in U. S. Government securities, and \$55 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$60 million in bills.
