## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 18, Member bank reserves decreased \$58 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were decreases of \$264 million in Reserve Bank credit and \$110 million in Gold stock, and an increase of \$65 million in Other F. R. accounts (net). The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$122 million in Money in circulation, \$100 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$96 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$36 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$24 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$264 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$597 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$39 million in U. S. Government securities, and an increase of \$373 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities reflected a decrease of \$39 million in bills.
