CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended July 22, Member bank reserves increased \$345 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$342 million in Reserve Bank credit and decreases of \$112 million in Money in circulation, \$101 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$36 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$144 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and a decrease of \$98 million in Gold stock.

The increase of \$342 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$321 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$21 million in Float.
