### CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended October 14, Member bank reserves increased \$254 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$176 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$23 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$13 million in Treasury cash holdings, and an increase of \$84 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$38 million in Money in circulation.

The increase of \$84 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$79 million in Float and \$15 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and a decrease of \$10 million in Loans, discounts and advances.
