CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 10, Member bank reserves decreased \$216 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$181 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$11 million in Treasury cash holdings, and a decrease of \$45 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The decrease of \$45 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$89 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and decreases of \$75 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$60 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected an increase of \$89 million in bills.
