CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended February 17, Member bank reserves increased \$191 million. The principal changes increasing reserves were an increase of \$82 million in Reserve Bank credit and decreases of \$105 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$102 million in Money in circulation. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$84 million in Other F. R. accounts (net).

The increase of \$82 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$289 million in Float and decreases of \$149 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$57 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected an increase of \$235 million in certificates and a decrease of \$235 million in notes, with no change in the total.
