## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended March 17, Member bank reserves increased \$667 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$396 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$155 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$101 million in Money in circulation, and an increase of \$66 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$41 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$12 million in Other F. R. accounts (net).

The increase of \$66 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from an increase of \$312 million in Float and decreases of \$146 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$100 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright. The decrease of \$100 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright was entirely in bills.
