CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended March 24, Member bank reserves decreased \$568 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$488 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$167 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$79 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$137 million in Money in circulation, \$13 million in Treasury cash holdings, and \$11 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$79 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from a decrease of \$286 million in Float and increases of \$83 million in Loans, discounts and advances, \$73 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and \$50 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected an increase of \$50 million in bills.
