## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended May 5, Member bank reserves decreased \$492 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$132 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$118 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$111 million in Money in circulation, and \$23 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$109 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The decrease of \$109 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$77 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$32 million in Float.
