CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended May 12, Member bank reserves increased \$274 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$210 million in Reserve Bank credit and decreases of \$75 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$22 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$29 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The increase of \$210 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$128 million in Loans, discounts and advances and \$81 million in Float.
