CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended July 14, Member bank reserves decreased \$354 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$257 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$200 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$20 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$67 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$173 million in Money in circulation and \$16 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The decrease of \$67 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$135 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and \$1 million in Loans, discounts and advances, and an increase of \$69 million in Float. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected a decrease of \$135 million in bills.
