## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended August 18, Member bank reserves increased \$45 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$117 million in Reserve Bank credit and decreases of \$45 million in Money in circulation and \$11 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$53 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$40 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$23 million in Other F. R. accounts (net), and \$13 million in Treasury cash holdings.

The increase of \$117 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$212 million in Float and \$80 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and decreases of \$147 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and \$28 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected a decrease of \$147 million in bills.
