## CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended September 1, Member bank reserves decreased \$49 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were an increase of \$137 million in Money in circulation and a decrease of \$49 million in Gold stock. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$79 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$13 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and an increase of \$31 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The increase of \$31 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from increases of \$70 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and \$45 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and decreases of \$64 million in Float and \$20 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected an increase of \$70 million in bills.
