CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended October 27, Member bank reserves decreased \$149 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were a decrease of \$224 million in Reserve Bank credit and increases of \$13 million in Treasury cash holdings and \$9 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$85 million in Money in circulation and \$13 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$224 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$124 million in Float, \$75 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright, and \$25 million in Loans, discounts and advances. Holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright reflected a decrease of \$75 million in bills.
