CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

Member Bank Reserves and Related Items

During the week ended December 8, Member bank reserves increased \$129 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$392 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$28 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$10 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$193 million in Money in circulation and a decrease of \$107 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The decrease of \$107 million in Reserve Bank credit resulted from decreases of \$75 million in Float and \$31 million in Loans, discounts and advances.
