## BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE SYSTEM

WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of Member bank reserve balances for the week ending May 25 decreased \$180 million to \$18,673 million. The principal changes decreasing reserves were increases of \$127 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$44 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$13 million in Other F. R. accounts (net), and a decrease of \$74 million in Reserve Bank credit. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$51 million in Money in circulation and \$23 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks.

The decrease of \$74 million in average Reserve Bank credit for the week resulted principally from decreases of \$151 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and \$23 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and an increase of \$117 million in Member bank borrowings.

At the end of the week, May 25, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$99 million lower than a week earlier, and Member bank borrowings were \$233 million higher.
