## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of Member bank reserve balances for the week ending June 1 decreased \$177 million to \$18,496 million. The principal changes reducing reserves were increases of \$145 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$135 million in Money in circulation, and \$57 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$167 million in Reserve Bank credit.

The increase of \$167 million in average Reserve Bank credit for the week resulted principally from increases of \$192 million in Member bank borrowings and \$87 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright, and a decrease of \$108 million in Float.

At the end of the week, June 1, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$180 million higher than a week earlier and Member bank borrowings were \$23 million higher.
