WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of Member bank reserve balances for the week ending June 15 increased \$30 million to \$18,678 million. The principal changes supplying reserves were decreases of \$136 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$29 million in Other deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were a decrease of \$88 million in Reserve Bank credit and an increase of \$47 million in Foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Estimated average excess reserves of member banks for the week decreased \$14 million to \$606 million.

The decrease of \$88 million in average Reserve Bank credit for the week resulted principally from decreases of \$95 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and \$19 million in Float, and an increase of \$26 million in Member bank borrowings.

As of Wednesday, June 15, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$61 million lower than a week earlier and Member bank borrowings were \$445 million higher.
