## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of member bank reserves for the week ending March 21 increased \$513 million to \$19,204 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$372 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$141 million to \$622 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$312 million, compared with \$494 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying reserves were an increase of \$485 million in Federal Reserve float, and decreases of \$75 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$27 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$12 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$48 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net) and a decrease of \$41 million in member bank borrowings. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$446 million.

As of Wednesday, March 21, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$4 million lower than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$74 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$357 million higher. Holdings of certificates increased \$5,012 million and notes decreased a like amount, reflecting the exchange of notes maturing March 15 and April 1 for Series A-1957 certificates.
