WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of member bank reserves for the week ending June 20 increased \$367 million to \$19,116 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$272 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$95 million to \$606 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$158 million, compared with \$231 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying reserves were increases of \$537 million in Federal Reserve float and \$22 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$137 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$18 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$16 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net), and a decrease of \$24 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$528 million.

As of Wednesday, June 20, holdings of U.S. Government securities and those held under repurchase agreement were unchanged from a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$71 million higher.
